ELIGIBILITY

Any artist or collaborative group adult or child, can submit one or more donated Scarecrow Sculptures to be available for display and for a live auction.

ACCEPTANCE

- Works can be of any material that can hold up to the elements.
- Works are encouraged to be “Green” in the recycled sense or use recycled materials.
- Works must be free standing. Fence posts/ stakes will be available for securing works.
- Works must be able to be transported with a minimum amount of assembly.
- Works must not weigh more than 30 lbs. per section, if assembled.
- Artists are asked to submit a typed Artist Statement and current address/e-mail with the application. Statement to be displayed at time of auction.

BENEFITS TO THE ARTIST

- Artists or group representative will have 2 tickets (\$40 value) admission to the Live Auction/Reception.
- Artist or Group representative will be listed in the auction program.
- Artist or Group will have their work on Northeast Arts KC’s web site with credits and acknowledgments.
- Notice will be given as to the purchaser of the work.

A panel of 3 judges will award the following \$100 prizes: Green Award • Peoples Choice

- Best use of light or solar energy

FOR SCARECROWS IN SCARRITT
